From the Transportation Dept.:

[W. Chapel Hill Street between Pettigrew Street and Great Jones Street](#) travel lanes will be impacted on Monday, February 3rd at 9:00AM. The street closure is expected to be in place on the following days/times for approximately *three to four days*.

- Southern Pier (eastbound traffic impacts) – Monday (9:00 AM-4:00 PM)
- Middle Pier (eastbound/westbound traffic impacts) – Tuesday (9:00 AM-4:00 PM)
- Northern Pier (westbound traffic impacts) – Wednesday (9:00 AM-4:00 PM)
- Project completion - Thursday (If Necessary) – (9:00 AM-4:00 PM - Only necessary if weather impacts progress)
- The roadway will be reopened to pedestrian, bicycle and vehicle traffic at the end of each work day.

The purpose of the daily road closure is to complete the final pressure washing of the [Chapel Hill Street railroad overpass and bridge supports](#).

- W.M. Brode's traffic control subcontractor will setup a pedestrian, bicycle and vehicle traffic detour route around the construction site
- Bus routes will be diverted around the site for the duration of the construction effort. Please see <https://gotriangle.org/> for up to the minute transit service alerts.
- Please allow some additional time during your commute during the construction effort
