



# Downtown Durham Construction Projects and Special Events Update December 1<sup>st</sup> - December 10<sup>th</sup>

*December 1, 2017*

Please note – the projects included in this work plan are current as of the above publication date, and are subject to change based on weather conditions and other unforeseen circumstances.

## ***Current Project Highlights***

- [Durham Holiday Parade and Fun Fest](#) – Dynamic floats, hometown bands, drill teams, schools and community groups make their way down Main Street on December 2<sup>nd</sup> starting at 11AM.
- [Central Park Waterline Repairs](#) – Further improvements to the City's waterline infrastructure will continue in Central Park.
- [Van Alen Apartments](#) – Northwood Ravin is scheduled to complete a concrete delivery and form work.
- [Durham Mixed-Use Parking Garage Construction](#) – Construction activity for the new parking garage on Morgan Street will continue throughout the week.
- [Durham Innovation District](#) – Barnhill Contracting is scheduled to complete utility work along Morris Street.
- [One City Center](#) – AHCC is scheduled to complete project deliveries along West Parrish Street.
- [Duke Energy Utility Installation](#) – Evening utility work will be completed along West Chapel Hill Street.
- [PSNC Sidewalk Repairs](#) – Sidewalk repairs will be completed near the intersection of Main Street and Church Street along West Chapel Hill Street.
- [Traffic Signal Removal Study](#) – The traffic signal at the intersection of Foster Street and Corporation Street is under study for removal.

- **Saturday - Sunday December 2-3, 2017:**

- No work planned.

- **Week of November 6, 2017:**

- Hunt Street will be reduced to one lane as water line installation continues.
  - Traffic control signs and markings will be used for all traffic detours.
  - Flaggers will be utilized for traffic control.
  - Sidewalk traffic will be disrupted.
  - Noise levels in excess of the current City noise ordinance are anticipated during work hours.
  - On-street parking will be closed in work areas.
  - Planned work hours are 7 AM to 6 PM.
  - No water or sewer service disruptions are anticipated.
- Roney Street will be closed as sanitary sewer line installation begins.
  - Traffic control signs and markings will be used for all traffic detours.
  - Flaggers will be utilized for traffic control.
  - Sidewalk traffic will be disrupted.
  - Noise levels in excess of the current City noise ordinance are anticipated during work hours.
  - On-street parking will be closed in work areas.
  - Planned work hours are 7 AM to 6 PM.
  - No water or sewer service disruptions are anticipated.
- Periodic one-lane interruptions will occur on Corporation Street between Foster Street and North Duke Street as water services are connected to the new water line.
  - Flaggers will be utilized for traffic control.
  - Sidewalk traffic will be disrupted.
  - Noise levels in excess of the current City noise ordinance are anticipated during work hours.
  - On-street parking will be closed in work areas.
  - Planned work hours are 7 AM to 6 PM.
  - Residents and business owners will be contacted in advance of any service disruptions.

**Saturday - Sunday December 9-10, 2017:**

- No work planned. Roney Street will be closed between Corporation Street and Central Park.
  
- **Van Alen Apartments**

- **Durham Mixed-Use Parking Garage Construction** – On-site construction activity for the new parking garage on Morgan Street (between Mangum Street and Rigsbee Street) will continue on the following dates/times;

  - Duke Energy is planning to close Market Street to through traffic (between Parrish Street and Chapel Hill Street) on the following dates/times;
    - Monday, December 4<sup>th</sup> (9:00 AM – 4:00 PM)
    - Tuesday, December 5<sup>th</sup> (9:00 AM – 4:00 PM)
  - Proper pedestrian and traffic controls will be in place. Entryways to all businesses will remain accessible at all times.
  
- **PSNC Sidewalk Repairs**
  - PSNC's sidewalk contractor will be repairing damaged sidewalk near the intersection of Main Street and Church Street on the following dates/times;
    - Tuesday, December 5<sup>th</sup> (9:00 AM – 4:00 PM)

- Two-way traffic will be maintained via a flagging operation. Proper pedestrian and traffic controls will be in place. Entryways to all businesses will remain accessible at all times.
