

Downtown Durham Construction Projects and Special Events Update November 10th - November 19th

November 9th, 2017

Please note – the projects included in this work plan are current as of the above publication date, and are subject to change based on weather conditions and other unforeseen circumstances.

Current Project Highlights

- NC 147 Overnight Closures NCDOT will close all northbound and southbound lanes of NC 147 on Sunday, November 12th, from Midnight to 7:00 AM.
- <u>Central Park Waterline Repairs</u> Further improvements to the City's waterline infrastructure will continue in Central Park.
- <u>Van Alen Apartments</u> Northwood Ravin is scheduled to complete a concrete delivery and form work.
- <u>Durham Mixed-Use Parking Garage Construction</u> Construction activity for the new parking garage on Morgan Street will continue throughout the week.
- <u>Durham Innovation District</u> Barnhill Contracting is scheduled to complete utility work along Morris Street.
- One City Center AHCC is scheduled to complete project deliveries along West Parrish Street.
- <u>Duke Energy Utility Installation</u> Evening utility work will be completed along West Parrish Street.

Temporary Road/Lane Closures

- Central Park Waterline Repairs
 - <u>Week of November 13, 2017:</u>
 - Mangum Street will be reduced to one lane as water line installation begins.
 - Traffic control signs and markings will be used for all traffic detours.
 - Flaggers will be utilized for traffic control.
 - Sidewalk traffic will be disrupted.

- Noise levels in excess of the current City noise ordinance are anticipated during work hours.
- On-street parking will be closed in work areas.
- Planned work hours are 7 AM to 6 PM.
- No service disruptions are anticipated. Residents will be notified in advance of any disruption.
- Hunt Street will be reduced to one lane as water line installation begins.
 - Traffic control signs and markings will be used for all traffic detours.
 - Flaggers will be utilized for traffic control.
 - Sidewalk traffic will be disrupted.
 - Noise levels in excess of the current City noise ordinance are anticipated during work hours.
 - On-street parking will be closed in work areas.
 - Planned work hours are 7 AM to 6 PM.
 - No water or sewer service disruptions are anticipated.
- Roney Street will be closed as sanitary sewer line installation begins.
 - Traffic control signs and markings will be used for all traffic detours.

 - Sidewalk traffic will be disrupted.
 - Noise levels in excess of the current City noise ordinance are anticipated during work hours.
 - On-street parking will be closed in work areas.
 - Planned work hours are 7 AM to 6 PM.
 - No water or sewer service disruptions are anticipated.

Van Alen Apartments

 - Wednesday, November 15th (1:00 AM 3:00 AM) Formwork

- <u>Durham Mixed-Use Parking Garage Construction</u> On-site construction activity for the new parking garage on Morgan Street (between Mangum Street and Rigsbee Street) will continue throughout the week. Utility work will take place along Rigsbee Street on the following dates/times;
 - Friday, November 10th (9:00 AM 4:00 PM)
 - Monday, November 13th (9:00 AM 4:00 PM)
 - Tuesday, November 14th (9:00 AM 4:00 PM)
 - Wednesday, November 15th (9:00 AM 4:00 PM)
 - Thursday, November 16th (9:00 AM 4:00 PM)
 - Friday, November 17th (9:00 AM 4:00 PM)
 - Proper pedestrian and traffic controls will be in place. Entryways to all businesses will remain accessible at all times.
 - Construction site fencing will be setup along the south sidewalk of Morgan Street during the week of November 13th. Proper pedestrian and traffic

controls will be in place. Parking along the south curb line of Morgan Street will be removed throughout this phase of construction.

- A concrete pour is scheduled at the intersection of Roney Street at Morris Street on the following date/times;

- Utility work will require lanes closure along Morris Street on the following dates/times;
