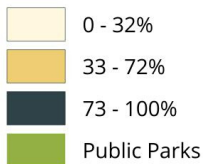

\$1,623 per year for each resident funds PUBLIC SCHOOLS, PUBLIC HEALTH, and SERVICES that your family relies on!



WHAT? Every 10 years, the US Census counts each person in the US. North Carolina loses \$16,000 for each person not counted.



WHY? Census data is used by the state, county, and city to plan for and fund everything from Head Start to high school and healthcare to highways.



WHEN? You will receive instructions in the mail by April 1. One person should count every member of your household and submit the information.



HOW? You can reply online, by phone, or by mail. If you do not respond, local census staff will go door-to-door to make sure your household is counted.



WHERE? Visit **2020census.gov**. If you don't have access to a computer at home, visit your local library.
